Wind Energy Comes Out on Top

Wind energy has spiked to the top of the list of U.S. utility-scale clean energy resources for the first time this year, surpassing hydropower for first place. This is a big accomplishment for the wind industry, considering hydropower currently accounts for a 7% share of total U.S. electricity generation. With both wind and solar growing steadily, forecasts predict that renewable generation will comprise 18% of the U.S. energy mix this year and grow to nearly 20% in 2020. In addition, the Energy Information Association (EIA) predicts that natural gas-fired generation will increase, while coal-fired and nuclear generation are expected to decline. It's a clear signal that state and federal policies to support the development of new renewables are making significant advances toward a cleaner environment.
